- **PREAMBLE**: These Bye-Laws are made by the Civil Aviation Authority of Botswana with the approval of the Minister of Transport and Communications under Section 8 (2) of the Civil Aviation Act, 2011.
- **CITATION**: These Bye Laws may be cited as the Civil Aviation Authority of Botswana (Maintenance and Operational Experience) Bye Laws.

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Civil Aviation Bye-Law (CABY) is to clarify the requirements for the maintenance of aeroplanes over 5700 kg maximum certificated take-off mass and helicopters over 3175 kg maximum certificated take-off mass.

2. APPLICABILITY

This Bye-Law shall apply to all Air Operator Certificate holders in the Republic of Botswana.

3. EFFECTIVITY

This Civil Aviation Bye-Law (13-2014) shall become effective immediately.

5. REQUIREMENTS

5.1 An Air Operator Certificate holder who operates an aeroplane over 5700 kg maximum certificated take-off mass or a helicopter over 3,175 kg maximum certificated take-off mass shall monitor and assess maintenance and operational experience with respect to continuing airworthiness and have a system whereby information on faults, malfunctions, defects and other occurrences that cause or might cause adverse effects on the continuing airworthiness of the aircraft is transmitted to the organization responsible for the type design of the aircraft.

6. GUIDANCE

This Bye-Law shall be read together with Civil Aviation (Air Operator Certification and Administration) Regulations.
