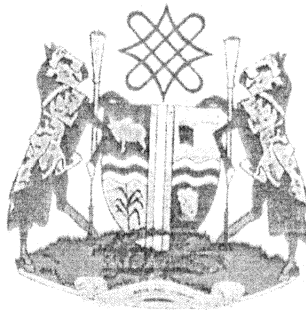


**A LAW TO SUBSTITUTE THE KADUNA STATE COMMERCIAL
MOTORCYCLE PROHIBITION LAW, NO. 5 OF 2014**



Kaduna State of Nigeria

Law No. 6 2018

(16th February 2018)

Date of Commencement

BE IT ENACTED by the House of Assembly of Kaduna State as follows:- Enactment

1. This Law may be cited as the Kaduna State Motorcycles Prohibition Law, 2018. Short Title

2. This Law shall come into operation on the 16th day of February 2018. Commencement

3. In this Law, unless the context otherwise requires; Interpretation

“Court” includes a Mobile Court established in accordance with Section 9 of this Law;

“Arresting Officer” means the Police or an Officer of the Kaduna State Traffic Law Enforcement Agency (KASTLEA); and

“State” means Kaduna State.

4. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Kaduna State Commercial Motorcycles Law No. 4 of 1999, the Road Traffic Law Cap 135 Laws of Kaduna State 1991 (including any regulation made in pursuance thereof), no commercial motorcyclist shall operate in the areas specified in the Schedule. Prohibition

- (2) Any person who conveys a passenger on motorcycle shall be deemed a commercial motorcyclist and shall be treated in accordance with the provisions of this Law.
5. (1) Any person who contravenes the provisions of the Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine not less than ₦10,000.00 or not less than three months imprisonment or both. Offences
- (2) The passenger shall on conviction be liable to a fine of not less than ₦5,000.00 or not less than one month imprisonment or both.
- (3) (a) For any subsequent offence in the case of subsection (1) above, to a fine of not less than ₦20,000.00 or six months imprisonment or confiscation;
- (b) and in the case of subsection (2) hereof, to a fine of not less than ₦10,000.00 or not less than three months imprisonment or both.
6. Any court of competent jurisdiction in the areas designated in the Schedule shall try summarily all offenders arraigned before them and impose such punishment, sanction and make Order (including confiscation of the motorcycles) as may be necessary or expedient. Court with Jurisdiction
7. Upon an arrest, the arresting officer shall immediately arraign the suspect before the court for trial. Arraignment
8. The suspect may however be discharged if it satisfied he is not a commercial motorcyclist or that the circumstances forming the basis for the arrest were necessitated by: Discharge of Accused Person
- (a) humanitarian considerations; or
- (b) emergency situations aimed at saving lives and or properties.
9. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 6 of this Law, the Chief Judge of the State shall establish such number of Mobile Courts as may be considered appropriate to try violators of this Law. Mobile Courts

10. The Governor may at any time, by notice published in the State Gazette, expand or limit the areas to be affected by this Law. Powers of the Governor
11. The Kaduna State Commercial Motorcycles Prohibition Law No. 5 of 2014 is hereby repealed. Repeal

1. All Federal Roads (Trunk A) throughout the State**2. Kaduna Township and Environs:**

- (a) Kaduna North Local Government Area
- (b) Kaduna South Local Government Area
- (c) Chikun Local Government Area

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Unguwar Yelwa;
- Sabon Tasha – MararabanRido;
- Narayi;
- Unguwar Romi;
- Gonin Gora;
- Kamazo;
- Unguwar Boro;
- Nassarawa;
- Tirkania; and
- Kudendan.

- (d) Igabi Local Government Area

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Rigasa;
- Mando; and
- Rigachikun;

2. Zaria Township:

- (a) Sabon Gari Local Government Area

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Sabon Gari;
- Samaru;
- Basawa; and
- Hanwa.

(b) Zaria Local Government Area

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Zaria City;
- Wusasa;
- Gyallesu, Tudun Wada;
- Gwargwaji;
- Gaskiya;
- Tukur Tukur – Magume;
- Dan Magaji;
- Local Government Layout;
- Police Barracks; and
- State Polytechnic.

3. **Kafanchan Township:**

(a) Kafanchan Metropolitan Area

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Kagoro;
- Zikpak; and
- Other suburbs

(b) Kagoro – Manchok Highway

4. **Lere Local Government Area:**

(a) Abadawa – Unguwan Bawa

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Jos – Zaria Road, Saminaka

(b) Low Cost – Jaja Village

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Kano – Zango Road

5. **Birnin Gwari Local Government Area:**

(a) Unguwan Nachibi

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Birnin Gwari – Funtua Road;

(b) Kwadaga and Janbirni Villages

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Off BirninGwari – Funtua Road

(c) Dogon Dawa – Kaduna Road

6. **Giwa Local Government Area:**

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

(a) FarinRuwa – Zaria Road


(b) MararabanYakawada – Kuyello Road

7. **Kachia Local Government Area:**

Areas affected by the prohibition are:

- Katari – Jere Road


EXPLANATORY NOTE
