EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Act authorises the issue from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation the total sum of =N=9,120,334,988,225 (nine trillion, one hundred and twenty billion, three hundred and thirty four million, nine hundred and eighty-eight thousand, two hundred and twenty five Naira) only, of which =N=530,421,368,624 (five hundred and thirty billion, four hundred and twenty-one million, three hundred and sixty-eight thousand, six hundred and twenty-four Naira) only is for Statutory Transfers, =N=2,203,835,365,699 (two trillion, two hundred and three billion, eight hundred and thirty-five million, three hundred and sixty-five thousand, six hundred and ninety-nine Naira) only is for Debt Service, =N=3,512,677,902,077 (three trillion, five hundred and twelve billion, six hundred and seventy-seven million, nine hundred and two thousand and seventy-seven Naira) only is for Recurrent (Non-Debt) Expenditure while the sum of =N=2,873,400,351,825 (two trillion, eight hundred and seventy-three billion, four hundred million, three hundred and fifty-one thousand, eight hundred and twenty-five Naira) is for contribution to the Development Fund for Capital Expenditure for the financial year beginning from the date the Act comes into effect.

APPROPRIATION ACT, 2018

A Bill

An Act to authorise the issue from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation the total sum of =N=9,120,334,988,225 (nine trillion, one hundred and twenty billion, three hundred and thirty four million, nine hundred and eighty-eight thousand, two hundred and twenty five Naira) only, of which =N=530,421,368,624 (five hundred and thirty billion, four hundred and twenty-one million, three hundred sixty-eight thousand, six hundred and twenty-four Naira) only is for Statutory Transfers, =N=2,203,835,365,699 (two trillion, two hundred and three billion, eight hundred and thirty-five million, three hundred and sixty-five thousand, six hundred and ninety-nine Naira) only is for Debt Service, =N=3,512,677,902,077 (three trillion, five hundred and twelve billion, six hundred and seventy-seven million, nine hundred and two thousand and seventy-seven Naira) only is for Recurrent (Non-Debt) Expenditure while the sum of =N=2,873,400,351,825 (two trillion, eight hundred and seventy-three billion, four hundred million, three hundred and fifty-one thousand, eight hundred and twenty-five Naira) is for contribution to the Development Fund for Capital Expenditure for the financial year beginning from the date the Act comes into effect.

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Commencement

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria:

1. (1) The Accountant-General of the Federation shall, when authorised to do so by warrants signed by the Minister of Finance, pay, out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation during the financial year beginning from the date the Act comes into effect, sums specified by the warrants, not exceeding in the aggregate =N=9,120,334,988,225 only.
- (2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) shall be appropriated to the heads of expenditure as set out in the First Schedule.
- (3) No part of the amount shall be released from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation after the end of the year mentioned in subsection (1).

Issues and appropriation of ₦9,120,334,988,225 from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for 2018

First Schedule

2. All amounts appropriated under this Act shall be released from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation only for the purposes specified in the First Schedule.

Release of funds from the Consolidated Revenue Fund

First Schedule

3. In the event that the implementation of any of the projects intended to be undertaken under this Act cannot be completed without virement, such virement shall only be effected with the prior approval of the National Assembly.

(1) The Accountant-General of the Federation shall, immediately upon the coming into effect of this Act, maintain a separate record for the documentation of revenues accruing to the Consolidated Revenue Fund in excess of oil price benchmark adopted in this budget.</p> <p>(2) The revenues specified in subsection (1) refer to revenues accruing from sales of government crude oil in excess of the approved benchmark price per barrel, the petroleum profit tax and royalty on oil and gas.</p> | <p>Excess revenue</p> |

| <p>8.
