REGULATIONS

Made under section 37

THE COTTON (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1997

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Cotton (Amendment) Regulations, 1997, and shall be read as one with the Cotton Regulations, 1215

No. 536
of 1995

1995 herein referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended:

(a) in regulation 4 by deleting sub-regulation (2) of that regulation and substituting for it the following sub-regulation—

“(2) Cotton seeds for planting shall be sold to farmers by cotton seed dealers;”

(b) by deleting regulations 6 and 25;

(c) in regulation 27:

(i) by deleting that regulation and substituting for it the following—

“27. Cotton lint exporters shall pay an export levy of zero point five percentum (0.5%) of FOB value to the Board to finance the Board. This rate may be reviewed by the Minister from time to time.”

(ii) by adding the following regulation immediately below regulation 27—

“Levy for Research Funding 27A. Every seed cotton buyer shall pay towards research funding the sum of Tanzania shillings zero point five (0.5) for every kilogramme of seed cotton purchased. The Minister shall review this sum for research funding from time to time.”
