

THE PLANT PROTECTION DECREE, 1937.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraphs 2 and 5 of the Plant Protection Order, 1960. I hereby make the following Order:—

The Plant Protection (Exemptions) Order, 1960.

1. This Order may be cited as the Plant Protection (Exemptions) Order, 1960, and shall come into force on the 15th September, 1960.

2. The plants or parts of plants set out in the first column of the First Schedule hereto may be imported into the Protectorate without permit provided they originate from the countries set out in the second column of the said Schedule and conform to the conditions set out in the third column of the said Schedule.

3. The plants or parts of plants set out in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto are exempt from the necessity of being examined by an inspector in accordance with paragraph 5 (1) of the Plant Protection Order, 1960, provided they originate from the countries set out in the second column of the said Schedule and conform to the conditions set out in the third column of the said Schedule.
