*Governor*21st April, 1930**An Ordinance to amend the Land Ordinance**[25th April 1930]

ENACTED by the Governor of Tanganyika with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

1. This ordinance may be cited as the Land (Amendment) Ordinance, 1930.

Section 14 of

2. Section 14 of the Land Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the following for the last proviso thereto:-

“Provided that the Governor may without an auction grant a right of occupancy of a site for any church, chapel, mosque, school or other building used solely for religious or charitable purposes; for any cotton ginnery or cotton buying posts; for any purpose of Imperial Airways Limited, in carrying out any contract with His Majesty’s Government; for the purpose of giving effect to any licence to generate and supply electricity granted by the Government of the Territory; or for any public purpose.”

Passed in the Legislative Council on the seventeenth day of April, 1930.
