THE FOREST ORDINANCE

(CAP 389)

ORDER

Made under section 30

THE FORESTS (CONTROL OF MOVEMENT OF FOREST PRODUCE) (ALL SPECIES OF
TIMBER) ORDER, 1995

1. This Order may be cited as the (Control of Movement of Forest
Produce) (All Species of Timber) Order, 1995.

2. In this order timber means any tree or part of a tree which has
fallen or been felled or cut off, and all wood whether or not sawn, split
hewn or otherwise cut up or fashioned including firewood or poles.

Forest Control of Movement of Forest Produce) (All Species of Timber)

G.N. No. 509 (contd.)

3. No person shall move from any part of Tanzania Mainland any timber without first obtaining a Timber Movement permit from the Chief Conservator or any other Officer authorized by him to do so on his behalf.

4.—(1) The issue of a permit shall be in the absolute discretion of the Chief Conservator or any other Officer authorized by him, who may issue a permit for such quantities of timber and upon such terms and conditions as he may think fit.

5. Any person who contravenes any provision of this Order; shall, on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding three thousand shillings or a term of imprisonment not exceeding six months.
