| <p>1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Local Manufacturing and Importation of Incandescent Bulbs and Energy Inefficient Lighting Devices) (Prohibition) Regulations, 2016.</p> | Title |
| <p>2. (1) The manufacturing and importation of the goods specified in the Schedule is prohibited from the dates specified in that Schedule.</p> <p>(2) The sale of the goods specified in the Schedule is prohibited from 30th June, 2017.</p> <p>(3) The ban on incandescent bulbs shall apply to all lighting appliances.</p> | Prohibition of manufacturing, importation and sale of bulbs and devices |
| <p>3. These Regulations do not apply to specialised lighting equipment for specified uses, where no other lighting equipment is available, including—</p> <p>(a) infra-red lamps for chicken brooding;</p> <p>(b) lighting equipment for experimental and research purposes;</p> <p>(c) lighting for medical equipment; and</p> <p>(d) automobile lighting.</p> | Exceptions |
